

# Hall Of Fame Rules

## 1. Purpose

The purpose of the Affenpinscher Alliance of the Americas Hall of Fame shall be to bring recognition and honor to Affenpinschers who have made outstanding contributions to the development of the breed across the globe.

## 2. Criteria

- a. Must be an Affenpinscher deemed to have made a significant contribution to the Affenpinscher breed. This can mean exceptional merit in his/her own right or through contributions via his/her progeny/get.
- b. Any dog that has the distinction of being the “first” in any category for milestones in event competition, breeding, and other achievements deemed notable by the AAA.
- c. All dogs qualifying for the Affenpinscher Alliance of the Americas Registry of Merit will automatically be listed in the Hall of Fame.

## 3. Committee

- a. The governing body of the Affenpinscher Alliance of the Americas shall be the Hall of Fame committee.
- b. The committee will make all decisions on which dogs are listed and for which achievement.

## 4. Procedures for Submission

Anyone wishing to submit a dog for consideration for the AAA Hall of Fame must include:

1. Dog’s full AKC, or other recognized foreign registry, name including all titles.
2. AKC or other recognized foreign registry number.
3. Date of birth, date of death.
4. Breeder’s name.
5. Three generation pedigree (parents, grandparents, and great-grandparents).
6. Owner’s name and current address.
7. Summary of history of accomplishments and/or contributions.
8. A photograph of the dog.

## 5. Foundation Members of the Hall of Fame

Dogs fitting the criteria for the AAA Hall of Fame will be inducted based on historical research and records. Any dog that has a record/achievement that is unrecorded may be submitted by anyone with proper AAA acceptable documentation.
